Subject: Electronic Reproduction and/or Printing of U.S. Customs and Border Protection Forms

Customs and Border Protection (CBP) Directive number 2110-036A, dated April 19, 2003, outlined the requirements for the electronic reproduction and/or private printing of CBP forms.

Prior to submission to a Customs port, any CBP form that is electronically reproduced and/or privately printed must be submitted for approval to the Forms Management Officer (FMO) at Headquarters. The FMO will provide a written approval or denial for each request.
