Conditions of Entry Notice for Republic of Congo Published

The Coast Guard announced today *Federal Register* publication of a notice that conditions of entry have been removed for vessels arriving from ports in the Republic of Congo.

Based on recent information, the Coast Guard has determined that the Republic of Congo is now maintaining effective anti-terrorism measures, and is accordingly removing the conditions of entry previously announced by notice in the *Federal Register*.
