At this time, the Nederland Terminal can only receive crude oil with a maximum temperature of 120 degrees Fahrenheit. Please note – this is a **maximum** temperature. The actual allowable temperature varies depending on the product in the receiving tank.

As is stated in the Nederland Terminal Port Manual Section 7 Paragraph L, "Maximum temperatures limits shall also be determined at the pre-cargo transfer conference."

The above information specifying Maximum Crude Oil Temperature will be included in the next revision of the Nederland Terminal Port Manual.
